Sealed bids for the above-referenced project will be received by Erwin Utilities Authority ("Owner"), at 244 Love Street, Erwin, TN 37650, until 2:00 p.m. Eastern on Monday, August 31, 2026 ("Bid Deadline"). Bids received after the Bid Deadline will be returned unopened.

1. Project Description

The Work generally consists of the repair and/or replacement of components of the Erwin Utilities Authority Wastewater Treatment Plant that were damaged as a result of Tropical Storm Helene, which impacted the region beginning on September 26, 2024, including but not limited to replacement of damaged process units, blowers/pumps, electrical and control systems, structural repairs to tanks and basins, fencing and site restoration, etc.]. A complete itemized scope of work is contained in the Bid Schedule.

2. FEMA-Funded Project Notice

This project is being funded, in whole or in part, with financial assistance from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance (PA) Grant Program, administered through the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency (TEMA). Prospective bidders are not required to submit bids for all elements of the project; Partial bids will be accepted. Bidders are advised that the Owner may choose to award portions of the work subject to the continued availability of FEMA/State disaster assistance funding.

3. Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) Requirement

Each bidder shall submit a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) demonstrating the bidder's experience, capacity, and ability to satisfactorily perform the Work. Bids submitted without a complete SOQ may be deemed non-responsive. The SOQ shall be submitted as a separate sealed section accompanying the bid and shall include, at a minimum:

- Firm name, business address, contractor license number(s), and state of incorporation/registration;
- Evidence of at least two (2) years of experience performing wastewater/water treatment plant construction or rehabilitation of similar scope and complexity;
- A minimum of three (3) references for comparable projects completed within the last five (5) years, including owner contact information, contract value, and dates of performance;
- Resumes of the proposed project manager, superintendent, and key personnel who will be assigned to the project;
- A list of proposed major subcontractors and suppliers, with evidence of their relevant experience;
- Disclosure of any pending or completed litigation, contract terminations, or debarment/suspension actions within the past five (5) years;
- Confirmation that the bidder is not presently debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from participation in federally funded procurements (SAM.gov exclusion check).

The Owner reserves the right to request additional qualification information, to interview proposed bidders, and to reject any bid where the SOQ does not demonstrate, to the Owner's satisfaction, the ability to perform the Work.
